- Go-Ahead Ireland Club Community Spirit Award 2023

These awards have the purpose of recognising the incredible work and commitment of Dublin GAA Clubs, Players, Volunteers and Officials, which play within the Go-Ahead Ireland Leagues and Championships throughout the years of 2022 and 2023.

Clubs who wish to take part should submit their entries for one or both awards themselves, with submissions to be judged by a mixed selection panel, facilitated by Dublin GAA.

Go-Ahead Ireland Referee Recognition Award 2023

Submission Requirements

Written Component – 150 to 300 words.

O Component should mention a referee who has made, in the opinion of the club, an outstanding contribution to referring via their influence, support, advocacy, or other positive action.

Terms and Conditions

- Clubs should make a submission on behalf of the referee they wish to nominate.
 - O The referee which they are nominating should be affiliated with the Club.
- All entries must be submitted via the form found on the Dublin GAA official website.
 (https://www.dublingaa.ie/news/go-ahead-dublin-gaa-club-awards-2023). Entrants must provide their written material.
- All entrants (the referee being represented) must have participated within the Go- Ahead Ireland Leagues and/or Championships throughout 2023.
- Please include the nominated referee's name as the title for your submission. This title will be used to reference your submission in post awards entrants' releases on both Go-Ahead Ireland and Dublin GAA's platforms.
- By entering the awards, you are agreeing to allow both Go-Ahead Ireland and Dublin GAA to utilize the nomination (written component) by sharing on their social media and website.
- All entries must be submitted via the form found on the Dublin GAA official website by 23:59 12th November 2023.
- The judging panel's decisions are final, and awards will be made at their discretion.
- Feedback cannot be provided on entries.
- Awards will be judged based on points; in the event of a tie, the judging panel will select a victor.
- The winner of the award has the option to participate in a follow up video, produced by Go-Ahead Ireland and/or Dublin GAA.
- There are two placements, first and second.
 - O The affiliated club awarded first place will be awarded €3,000 by Go-Ahead Ireland.
 - The affiliated club awarded second place will be awarded €1,000 by Go-Ahead Ireland.
- Go-Ahead Ireland to visit first place winning club for presentation of award.

Submission Requirements

- 1. Written Component 150 to 300 words.
- Component should support the video with providing additional context and/or information.
- 2. Video Component No less than 45 seconds.

Terms and Conditions

- The submission for application will consist of a club produced video with supporting written material.
- The video component of the entry must clearly explain why the affiliated club should, in your words, be considered for the Go-Ahead Ireland Club Community Spirit Award.
- All entrants (the club being represented) must have participated within the Go-Ahead Ireland Leagues and/or Championships throughout 2022 or 2023.
- All entrants must upload their video to Vimeo (or another platform which allows for third-party download) and allow for download.
- The video component of the entry must explain why community involvement and improving the lives of those in the locality of the club is important to the club.
- All entries must be submitted via the form found on the Dublin GAA official website
 (https://www.dublingaa.ie/news/go-ahead-dublin-gaa-club-awards-2023). Entrants must also provide their written
 material.
- Please include a title for your submission. This title will be used to reference your submission in post awards entrants' releases on both Go-Ahead Ireland and Dublin GAA's platforms (Including social media and websites)
- By entering the awards, you are agreeing to allow both Go-Ahead Ireland and Dublin GAA to utilize the nomination (video & written component) by sharing on their social media and website.
- The video component of the entry must be no less than 45 seconds.
- All entries must be submitted via the form found on the Dublin GAA official website by 23:59 12th November 2023.
- The judging panel's decisions are final, and awards will be made at their discretion.
- Feedback cannot be provided on entries.
- Awards will be judged based on points; in the event of a tie, the judging panel will select a victor.
- The winner of the award has the option to participate in a follow up video, produced by Go-Ahead Ireland and/or Dublin GAA.
- There are two placements, first and second.
 - O The affiliated club awarded first place will be awarded €3,000 by Go-Ahead Ireland.
